Ray is a former governor of the Academy of Television Arts & Sciences, a former president of the Society of Composers and Lyricists, the professional organization for composers, and serves on the board of directors of the Film Music Society. He was appointed by the Library of Congress in 2005 to the National Film Preservation Board. For several years Ray has taught a class at UCLA Extension entitled "Music Production for Film and Television" and film composition at Columbia College.

STUDIO

Ray owns and operates a full-service 48-track recording studio, Superscore Studios. It features complete video lockup, 48-track Dolby SR, a digital Euphonix console with 288 automated inputs, 32 tracks of Protools HD digital editing, and is heavily set up for synthesizers and samplers, as well as a live room.
